45 new or enhanced bus services introduced in 2024 under the Connecting Ireland Rural Mobility Plan

Since the introduction of the Plan in October 2021 to date, over 150 new or enhanced bus routes have been rolled out nationwide under the operation of TFI Local Link, Bus Éireann and a variety of Commercial Bus Operators (CBO's). In 2024, 45 new/enhanced bus services were introduced under the Connecting Ireland Plan.

Since the roll out of the Connecting Ireland Rural Mobility Plan passenger journey numbers have seen significant growth across the country. The patronage on new/enhanced Connecting Ireland services grew 110% by the end of 2023, compared to 2019. The number of passengers using Connecting Ireland services in rural Ireland increased by 70% year-on-year from 2022 to 2023. As a result of the new or enhanced routes added to the TFI Public Transport Network in 2022 and 2023 combined, around 500,000 people now have access to Public Transport.





In 2024, patronage continued to grow as TFI Local Link Regular Rural Services (RRS) carried 4.7 million passengers which is up on 2023 figures of 3.2 million. In October 2024 specifically, TFI Local Link reached an outstanding achievement of carrying 100,000 passengers a week through the vast interconnected network. Similarly, since the end of 2023, passenger journey figures have grown 38% across Connecting Ireland Bus Éireann services.

In 2023, the services launched provided 190 new connections for towns and villages across rural Ireland, 34 college connections, 42 hospital connections and provided 49 connections to rail services meaning it is easier to access education and healthcare opportunities and connect to the wider TFI Network.

In 2024, a further 54 new towns and villages were connected to the TFI Public Transport Network, 22 rail connections, 19 hospital connections and 7 new higher education connections to colleges were created through the introduction of the new/enhanced services.



Enhanced Services in Action - Route 973 Cionn Fhánada to Letterkenny

As part of the Connecting Ireland Plan, the National Transport Authority (NTA) and TFI Local Link Donegal Sligo Leitrim identified a requirement for an enhancement of the existing bus service between Cionn Fhánada and Letterkenny to improve connectivity and mobility for the communities of Baile Láir, Portsalon, Kerrykeel, Rathmullan and Ramelton. The implementation of an enhanced bus service in these areas would greatly improve access to essential services and resources for residents living in these areas.

The enhanced Route 973, launched in October 2024, which was formerly known as Route 300 operates ten daily return services Monday to Sunday between Letterkenny and Kerrykeel with up to six daily return services to Baile Láir and four daily return services extending to Cionn Fhánada. The enhanced timetable now offers a convenient 2-hourly service between Letterkenny and Kerrykeel, 7 days a week.

The enhanced route improves connectivity to the towns and villages of Baile Láir, Portsalon, Kerrykeel, Rathmullan and Ramelton and provides peak-time and evening services for passengers and connectivity to ATU Donegal and regional bus services. In its first week the enhanced service carried over 900 passengers and continues to carry over 1,010 passengers a week.

Speaking on the success of Route 973, TFI Local Link Donegal Sligo Leitrim General Manager, Fiona O'Shea said "Route 973, now operates up to 10 daily return services between Letterkenny and Kerrykeel. This enhanced service has gone from strength to strength since its relaunch in October. The enhancements allow for improved connectivity to villages in the Fanad Peninsula, onward travel and peak-time services for students and commuters."
